Euraplan Offers Free Software

Software provider Euraplan is offering its OpenAIR systems - used for investment and accounting - for a nominal fee following a pricing re-structure.

Euraplan said it recognised pension funds' budgets were constrained in the current economic environment. However, the firm is also hoping to pick up business from smaller pension funds - less than GBP 100m under management - through the measure.

OpenAIR Investments and OpenAIR Accounts will be offered for a nominal administration fee and an annual fee that covers licences, maintenance and support.

The software will be provided free, said Euraplan.

The fee for the accounts system, the cheaper of the two, is GBP 3,000.
